How long will the session take?
Your session will take from 1-1/2 hour to 2 hours depending on the session you choose.

What outfit should I wear First?
You should arrive dressed with the outfit you would like to wear for our yearbook head and shoulders poses. Hair and make-up should be ready to go.

Hair...
Should be styled the way you want it to look when you arrive at the studio. You may want to have your hair professionally styled. Guys should not get a hair cut less than one week before your session.

Make - up...
Even though the trend is for less make-up we suggest wearing it for your portraits. A good base, set with powder evens out skin tones. Lipstick and eye make-up help to sharpen and define the lips and eyes. Make-up will also make your previews look better. Your hands will show in your portraits so make sure fingernails are groomed.

Colors...
For the head and shoulders outfit stay with medium shades. Not light, not dark, but right in the middle. Earth tones photograph extremely well and look especially nice for outdoor sessions, chambray and khakis or jeans. Blacks and browns photograph nicely as well as mono tone outfits.

What about jewelry?
For girls you can bring a change of jewelry for each outfit. For girls and guys don't forget your **class ring**.

What about props?
You are welcome to bring anything that will add to your ove all experience. If you play in a sport bring your jacket, uniform, and any equipment: ie. Balls, gloves, bats, helmet etc. If you have a hobby, bring something to reflect your interest.
